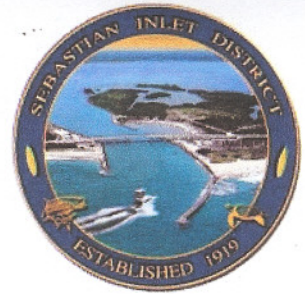

Letter of Reference

Land & Sea Surveying has been the lead surveying contract firm for the Sebastian Inlet District for the past three years. Twice a year (summer and winter) detailed bathymetric surveys are conducted 30,000 feet north and south of the inlet along transects every 1000 feet. The different domains of the inlet (flood and ebb shoals, sand trap, etc.) are divided into finer resolution bathymetric surveys to determine changes in sand volume for a sediment transport budget. Land & Sea utilizes previous surveys and a dtm to dtm comparison for quantity calculations for the sand budget.

Land & Sea have been utilized by the Inlet District for numerous other surveying efforts such as wetlands delineation, easement descriptions and legal descriptions for submerged land leases and leveling in field hydrographic instruments for hydrodynamic data collection.

Our experience with land & Sea Surveying has been impeccable in that they are always on schedule and within budget.
